## **Description:**

Fine example of Cornelis Claesz's map of America, first issued in his Spieghel der Spaenscher Tyrannye in 1596 and later re-issued in works by Barent Langenes and Petrus Bertius. The map is based upon Ortelius' map 1587 map of America, and identifies Anian, Quivira, Tolm R., Tototeac, Granada, Tamaco, Florida, Marata, Virginia, Nova Francia, Norembega, Cortercalis, Labrador, Bermuda and I. De Bacalaos in North America, along with showing the unknown southern continent. Nice full color excample, with wide clean margins and Latin text on the verso. Burden 92.
