Highly detailed map of the Chesapeake and Delmarva Peninsula and most of Virginia and Maryland, hand colored by counties. The map is dissected in 30 pieces and laid on linen, apparently done at or about the time of issuance, although including the original cloth covers from the original binding, but also with a marbled backing panel, suggesting that the linen is likely the originial presentation. The Lang & Cooper imprint appears to be a variant edition. A bit rubbed and scuffed at the bottom right corner and elsewhere, but overall a presentable example of the map, which was likely laid on linen for field use during the civil war. Top board detached but present. One panel partially split on two folds. A good example of a this scarce map, in a relatively unique format.
