Description:

Attractive full color example of the scarce Spanish edition of Henricus Hondius' derivative of John Smith's highly important 1612 map of Virginia, based upon the 1618 map of Henricus' brother Jodocus Hondius, the plate for which had been sold to Willem Blaeu by Jodocus' estates after his death in 1629. This was one of the first maps engraved by Henricus for his Atlantis Appendix of 1630. It is the only edition of the map where the Indian faces the Chesapeake. A nice old color example, which has been archivally backed to support the thinness caused by the oxidation of the greens in the map, with the color recently refreshed. Centerfold split just into the lower image, with just a tiny bit of restoration. Burden 228.
