A nice full color example of the 1642 Latin edition of Blaeu's map of the Southeast. This map is based on the larger 1606 Mercator-Hondius map. This map covers an area from the mouth of the Chesapeake bay to Georgia. On this map a number of settlements are named, including Jamestown (est 1609) and Newport News (est. 1621). One of the great early obtainable maps. Includes the marvelous mythical lakes in the interior and other conjectural cartography of the time. Large cartouche, 2 coasts of arms, 2 compass roses and several sailing ships. A striking example of this highly desireable map. Burden 253. Cumming 41.
