This map covers an area from the mouth of the Chesapeake bay to Georgia. On this map a number of settlements are named, including Jamestown (est 1609) and Newport News (est. 1621). One of the great early obtainable maps. Includes the marvelous mythical lakes in the interior and other conjectural cartography of the time.
