An attractive and highly detailed map of the Northern portion of the US, including the District of Main and Ohio, which is still called Western Territory. The map contains many worthy features. At the mouth of the Cayanhoga River on Lake Erie, there is a note concerning a 70 ft rock which makes navigation dangerous. Another note indicates that the easiest passage from Lake Erie to the Mississippi & Ohio Rivers is via the Sandusky & Sioto Rivers. A proposed fort is noted south of Detroit. The western boundary of the 6 Indian Nations in Western NY is noted. There are similar notes throughout the map, including annotations on each of the Great Lakes. The map is highly detailed and includes towns, roads, rivers, Indian details, springs, and a host of other information. A marvelous collector's map. A near fine example with wide clean margins.
