New Columbia stretches from the US Border to Russian America (Alaska). Lesser Slave Lake, Peace River, Mackenzie's River, Great Slave Lake, Churchill, Athabasca, Nelson, Englsih River, Cumberland, Norway, Red River, Rainy Lake, Severn, Swan River and Albany and Moore all appear and British Territorial names. The cartography in the West is of particular note. A wide margined example in vivid color. This is the rare 1859 edition which bears Johnson & Browning's imprint, shortly before they created their own *New Illustrated Family Atlas of the World*. Classical Colton decorative border.
