

The map shows the entrance to San Francisco Bay showing Ballenas Bay, Richardson's Bay, The City of San Francisco, Oakland, San Leandro and parts south, along with 3 large views of San Pablo, the entrance to the Bay from Yerba Buena, and a nice view of Alcatraz.
