

Description:

Scarce pair of maps of the Southeast, showing Georgia and South Carolina and including much of North Carolina, including Raleigh, Waynesboro, Cape Fear and Wilmington. Includes a Bermuda inset.

The maps extend south to include parts of Northern Florida, including Jacksonville and includes all of Georgia (including a massive Creek region), all of South Carolina and most of North Carolina.

An amazing work and a must for regional collectors. Perhaps the most detailed map of the region produced to that date. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale. His treatment of the Western US is a landmark in the history the cartography of the Western US, undertaking to map in 20 sheets a region which American publishers were virtually ignoring.
