



## **Description:**

This is the second edition of Henry Seile's map of America, first published in 1652. The map has been reengraved by Robert Vaughan at the directiion of Seile's widow Anae, making it the earliest map to show California as an Island published by a woman. The map is very simlar to he earlier map by Henry, although the nomenclature of the Deleware River, Carolina and several places on the west coast have been changes. A marvelous early American map. McLaughlin 35; Tooley p.115, no. 12; Burden 379. Narrow margins, with some loss at the margins (as issued), minor creasing and misfolding and minor remnants of old tape on the verso. Moderately toned. Still a good example of this early map of America. Normally a \$1500-2000 map.
