Description:

A rare map centered on the province of Genova and including Nice and northern Corsica.

Taken from *Les Cartes Generales . . .* published in Paris in 1634 and in Jean Boisseau's *Theatre Du Galles*, published in Paris in 1642. The map focuses on Liguria and the Northern part of Corsica. Tassin, was the Royal Cartographer of Dijon. Once he moved to Paris, his whole production was concentrated on small French maps.

On the lower left-hand corner, an eagle holding the title cartouche is depicted. The sea is also decorated by several ships and a sea monster.

A fine full color example of this great rarity.
