## **Description:**

Nice example of the th *e Atlas Minor* edition of Hondius' 1606 map of the coastline between Virginia and northern Florida, including the Carolinas and Georgia.

This example was published in Samuel Purchas' 1635 and 1637 *Historia Mundi*. The map retains much of the detail of the folio version of the map, including all of the Indian village names. The map is based upon the work of John White and Jacques LeMoyne, as interpeted by De Bry's maps of the explorations. One of the last maps to cartographically predate Smith's contribution and the settlement of Jamestown. Le Moyne's lake in Florida has been moved to central Florida, to accommodate the St. May (St. Johns) River, which flows easterly. The influence of Wytfliet and Ribaut are in evidence.
