

## **Description:**

Good example of the scarce is fine map of Alabama, from the first edition of Carey & Lea's Geographical, Statistical and Historical Atlas of America. Many counties still not formed. Size includes text below map, which includes wonderful contemporary details concerning the topography, indigenous lands, rivers, climate, towns, manufacturing, commerce, education, history, population by county (divided into white, free colored, and slaves) and information concerning important battles. From the first edition of Carey & Lea's Atlas. The atlas was issued in 6 editions in English, French & German between 1822 and 1827. While the 1822 edition is relatively common on the market, this later edition is much scarcer.

## **Detailed Condition:**

A bit of soiling near centerfold, but without glue stain, which so frequently affects the centerfold of the map.
