### Description:

Rare wall map of the Grass Valley and Nevada City area, showing land owners, geographical details, mining claims, roads, rivers, towns, mountains, etc. The map is rare, with only 3 recorded examples (Nevada County Library, UC Berkeley, Yale).

According to the California State Mining Bureau Bullentin, Charles Edward Uren was a resident of Alameda, California and the owner of the Lightner Mine in Calaveras County, the Superintendent of the Republican and Eagle-Shawmut Mines in Tuolumne County. He was also the father of Lester Charles Uren, who is credited with developing the first curriculum for teaching Petroleum Engineering (UC Berkeley).
