Finely executed map, based upon De L'Isle's landmark map of the region.

Excellent up to date map of Texas, Florida and the Gulf Coast, a region then only recently opened to non-Spanish Flag ships. The map also provides marvelous detail of the regions drained by the Mississippi, drawing upon the early French exploration of the region at the end of the 17th Century, which was just beginning to find its way into printed maps. The Apalachicola River, leading to Caskigi is one of the more more interesting features in the South. Excellent treatment of the Indians and villages and early French settlements in the interior of North America.
