This is one of the most embellished examples of this regional map ever produced. Includes 5 cartouches, 3 compass roses, over a dozen sailing ships and a number of ostriches and penguins, plus local hunters.

This view appeared in John Ogilby's seminal work, *America: Being the Latest, and Most Accurate* Description of the New World, published in London in 1671. Ogilby's work is an English translation of Arnoldus Montanus' Die Nieuwe en onbekende Weereld..., published in Amerstdam, although greatly expanded in some instances and with new maps and views.
