Description:

Striking and highly detailed map of the region around Rome, engraved by Giorgio Widman and published in Rome by Giacomo Rossi, the most important map maker working in Rome during the second half of the 17th Century.

Innocenzo Mattaei was appointed as the official cartographer to the Papal States by Pope Clemente X. The present map was originally prepared by Mattaei in 1666, and later engraved by Widman, and issued by the Rossi family in their *Mercurio Geographico*. It represents perhaps the most accurate and detailed map of the region to appear in a commercial atlas of the period and reflects the skill of the engraver and the high quality of engraving work being done in Rome in the second half of the 17th Century. During this period a new generation of Italian map makers produced a number of decorative and important separately issued maps and atlases at a scale not scene since Lafreri and his contemporaries work in the 1560s and 1570s.

Giorgio Widman engraved a number of maps for Rossi from 1672 to 1682. He also appears to have done some work for Guillaume Sanson during the period.
