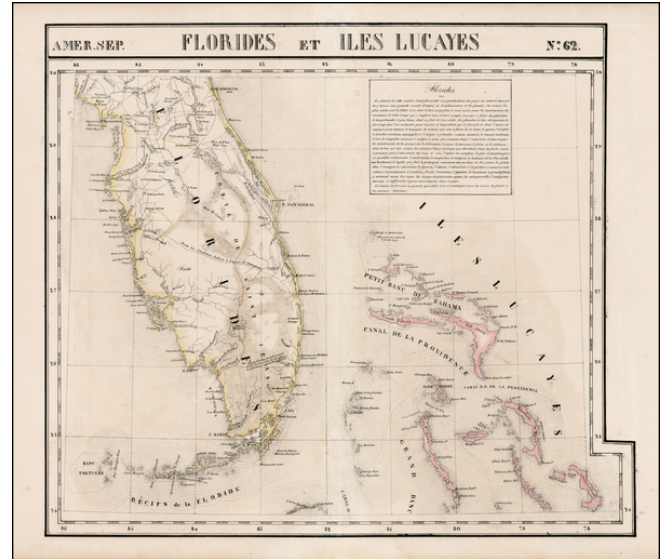

The map shows early roads in Florida, the Indian Trail which traverses the peninsula, annotations on the Everglades and many place names. Several early early colonies are noted. Excellent detail in the Keys. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
