

## **Description:**

Abraham Bradley's map was one of the earliest maps printed in America to extend to the Mississippi River. It notes the 5 proposed states of the Ordinance of 1789. Cincinnatus is shown. Chicago is shown, along with Detroit. A number of early forts appeare. The Land of the Six Nations is shown, as are New Connecticut, Ohio Company lands, the Seven Ranges, Ft. Knox, Ft. Vincennes, Ft. Hamilton, General Wayne's Treaty Line, Ft. Wayne, Ft. Miami, Ft. Franklin, early portages, and many notes on the regions in the west. This example has been archivally backed and shows signs of old tape repairs and some minor loss at the folds. Still, a nice example of what would ordinarily be a \$400.00 map.
