Large and detailed map of the Nile Delta, northern Sinai and Palestine to Acre and Jerusalem.

Of interest is the Pilgrims' Road from Cairo towards Mecca. It is likely that the map was published to satisfy public interest in the area after Nelson's Battle of the Nile (1798) and Abercrombie's victory at Alexandria (1801), which led to Napoleon being driven from Egypt.
