An uncommon map of the northern half of South America, focusing on the course of the Amazon River. The map is typical of Coronelli's strong engraving style the topographical features are very prominent.

The map is embellished with vignettes showing Native American life including several depictions of execution and cannibalism, indigenous animals, including elephants and lions! The scale miles is encircled in a ribbon that is being tied by a playful sea creature.
