## **Description:**

Rare first edition of Mercator's detailed regional map of Germany, form the first addition (1595) of Mercator's atlas.

The map tracks the course of the Elba River and its tributaries from Worlitz and Wittenberg to Prague in the south and the Oder River and its Tributaries, from Furstenberg to Neumarck, including Glogau and Crossen. Also shown is the course of the Sal River and its tributaries from Hall and Leipzig, along with the Mulda and other rivers. Very detailed, with many cities noted in gold.
