Interesting view of Spanish soldiers enforcing the new laws of the first Spanish Viceroy Blasco Núñez Vela, from De Bry's *Grand Voyage*.

Blasco Núñez Vela y Villalba (c. 1490 - January 18, 1546) was the first Spanish viceroy of Peru, from May 15, 1544 to January 18, 1546. He was charged by King Charles I with the enforcement of the controversial New Laws, which dealt with the failure of the encomienda system to protect the indigenous people of America from the rapacity of the conquistadors and their descendants.
