The map instead illustrates the mythical great rivers of the West, one extending from the Puget Sound area (Aguilar's Entre) to Lake Winnepeg and then on to Hudson Bay in a series of waterways. The second extending from San Francisco Bay to the Rockies, traversing a mythical mountain range. A decorative map with marvelous western cartography.
