## **Description**:

Fine example of Vander Aa's edition of Arnold Colom's very rare and imposing double-hemisphere map of the World, embellished mythological figures representing fire, air, day and night set against the skies and land, water against land- and seascapes.

California is shown as an island. The Australian coastlines are based upon the voyages of Abel Tasman. New Zealnd west coast is shown, as is a remnant of the unknown southern hemisphere.

The map was first published by J.Gottfried and was reissued by Pieter Van Der Aa with his own imprint and the French title "Nouveau Carte Du Monde" re-engraved in the lower cartouche.
