### Description:

Nice example of Jansson's rare map of America, in full original English color.

This extremely rare map of America first issued by Jan Jansson in 1623. The first edition of the map was issued separately and is known in only 1 example (Library of Congress).

Offered here is the the rare second state of the map, While at first blush the map appears similar to Blaeu's America, there are a number of differences. Jansson's map includes views of North America, including the Poeiock Village in North Carolina & views of Carolina and St. Augustine. The penninsular California is retained, with the extended Northwest Coast including definitive place names north of 40 degrees.

The East Coast of North America is rich with Indian names. The polar region inset is derived from Blaeu's wall map of 1608, as are the towns illustrated along the top.

This example was bound into a rare issue of Heyln's *Cosmographia*. Burden notes the existence of this map two known examples of Heylyn's work, a 1657 edition and a 1665 example in the British Library.

This example is in early ENGLISH color, which is very rare on the market and very different than contemporary Dutch color.
