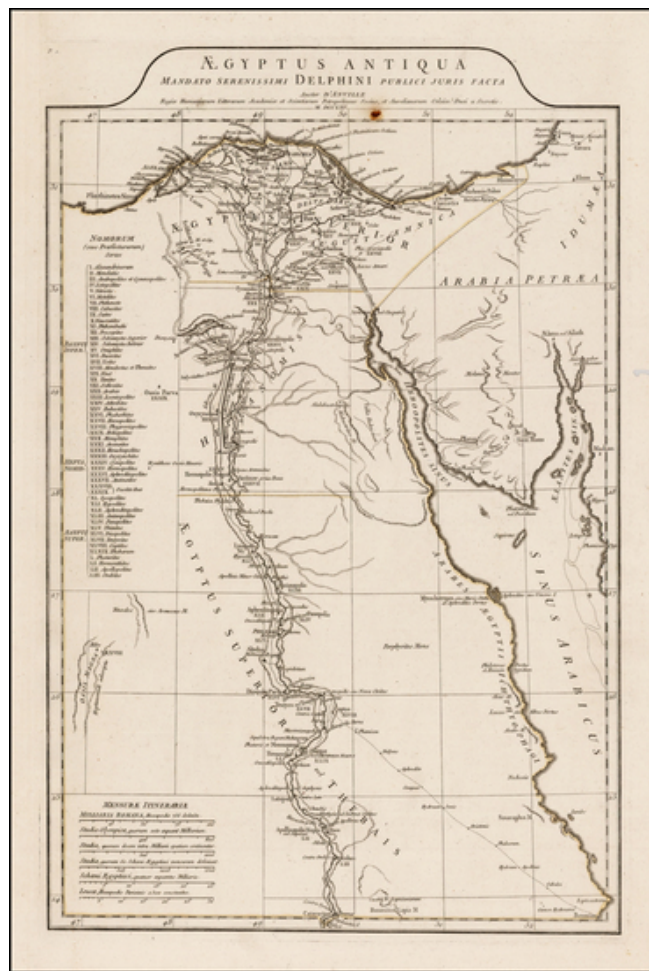

Detailed map of Ancient Egypt, following the Course of the Nile from the Cataracts Syene to the Mediterranean and also showing the overland route from Coptos the Brenice on the Red Sea.

On the left is a table showing the names of the local regions, divided in to 3 groups, Aegypti Infer. (Lower Egyptians), Hepta Nomid (Nomads?), and Aegypti Super (Upper Egyptians).

The map appeared in D'Anville's *Geographie Ancienne*, one of the most successful sets of large scale Ancient maps published in the 18th Century.
