One of the earliest large format maps to focus on New Zealand and the largest treatment of the Islands to date. The two sheets are extremely detailed for the time, coming prior to publication of Dumont D'Urville's seminal work. Includes dozens of place names and sounding on the coastlines, especially in the North. Extensive text notes. Several minor wormholes in the blank sea. A good example of this early and highly detailed regional map. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
