Highly detailed map of a portion of Australia, from the Cape Bernoulli area to Cap. Otway and Ile King, evidencing a somewhat tentative coastline in the regions which were just then being mapped for the first time.

Centered on Cape Northumberland, Cape Bridgewater and Cape Nelson. Includes some early exploration notes in the map and extensive text notes in the inset. A few minor wormholes, but no loss of image to the map. A good example of this early and highly detailed regional map.

From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
