

Marvelous pair of large scale maps of the Eastern and Western Hemisphere, showing the known World on the even of the Voyages of Captain James Cook.

The Northwest Coast of America is still largely unknown. Similarly, the Coastline of Australia is still largely conjecture and the third island of New Zealand is undiscovered.

There is no sign of any part of the Antarctic Coastline.

To his credit, D'Anville was a very disciplined mapmaker, so there is virtually no conjecture or myth in the details given in this map.
