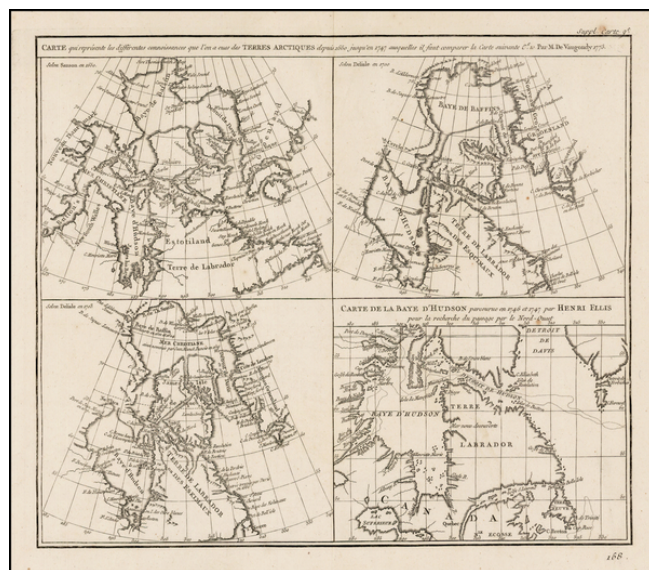

Marvelous set of four maps of the Hudson, Button and Baffin Bay regions, Davis Straits and the Coast Labrador, showing the evolution of the mapping and discoveries of these regions, as they were explored and mapped between 1650 and 1750.

This map was one of ten maps in Diderot's important 10 volume encyclopedia, one of the most important general compendiums of information of its time. It includes the work of Sanson (1650), De L'Isle (1700 and 1703) and Henri Ellis (1746-1747).
