Description:

Fine example of this striking view of the island of Vignole and its Monastery, built in 1422.

Fine bird's-eye view of the formerly famous monastery with all the gardens and greens, mostly demolished within the last 200 years. The view was engraved by Boschini for his *La Carta del Navegar pittoresco* (1660).

Marco Boschini (1613-1678), was an Italian painter and engraver of the early Baroque period in Venice. He was born in Venice, and was educated in the school of Palma il Giovane. He painted *The Last Supper* for the sacristy of San Girolamo at Venice. He also distinguished himself as an engraver and as a writer of art. He was the author of several publications, such as: *La Carta del Navegar pittoresco* (1660), a panygeric poem about Venetian painting, which included this view.
