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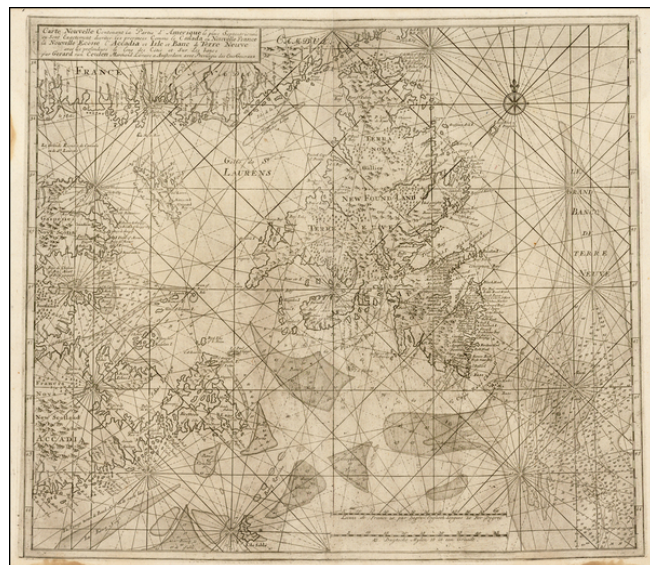

Scarce working sea chart of the Eastern Coastlines of Northern Canada and Newfoundland, from Van Keulen's Secret Atlas.

This scarce chart appeared in a very late edition of Van Kuelen's *Zee-Falkel*, one of the major works published by the Van Keulen, the dominant nautical chart maker in the Netherlands for over 100 years. While earlier Van Keulen maps from the 17th Century appear frequently on the market, the later charts, especially those issued after 1750, are very rare, as most copies of the work were used at sea and therefore very few survived.
