

## **Description:**

Fine example of the 1848 edition of the British Admiralty Chart of a large section of the East Coast of Australia, revised and improved to 1848.

The chart is based upon the surveys of Matthew Flinders, between 1799 and 1803, including the tracks of his ship the Investigator through the region. The chart also includes revisions based upon later explorations by Captains Phillip P. King (1826), F.P Blackwood (1844) and Captain O Stanley (1847).

The map extends from the area around Mackay in Queensland in the north to Cape Moreton in the South, with a detailed inset of the area around Rockhampton and Gladstone.
