The railroads are shown in exceptional detail, with every station in the state named. Southern California consists of only 5 counties (Los Angeles, San Diego, San Bernardino, Ventura, and Santa Barbara), with Ventura no longer called Buenaventura.

A massive Tulare Lake is still shown.

The tables include significant information, including details on California's Counties, agriculture, coal mining, etc.
