

Description:

One of the earliest obtainable maps of the District of Columbia to appear in a Commercial Atlas.

Includes a detailed plan of Washington DC, Georgetown and Alexandria and a number of roads and rivers in the District. Muds Tavern is shown just outside the District on the Frederickstown Turnpike. Carey & Lea's Atlas is highly prized not only for its cartographic information but also for the marvelous information about each of the states and territories included. The atlas was issued in 6 editions in English, French & German between 1822 and 1827.
