Description:

Highly detailed regional map of Western Australia, extending from Mt. Peron and the Arrowsmith River area along the NW Coast to Baie De L'Esperance, and the King George Sound area. The Riv. Des Cignes Noirs is shown, but no sign of Perth. Dozens of early place names. Several minor wormholes, but still an excellent example of this early and highly detailed regional map. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
