Rare set of 3 maps of the District of Columbia, illustrating the highway systems in and around the capital at the end of the 19th Century.

The titles for the 3 sections are:

- Highway Extension Plan of The District of Columbia -- First Section
- Permanent System of Highways. Section Section. District of Columbia. March 1898.
- Third Section. Permanent System of Highways, District of Columbia. October 1897.

The maps are of the utmost rarity. We find the maps referenced in *Bibliography of the District of Columbia* by Wilhemus Bogart Bryan (1900) and *List of Maps and Views of Washington and District of Columbia in the Library of Congress* (1900).
