

Description:

Gorgeous example of this early map of Wisconsin, issued 9 years after it first became a territory.

The lands south of the Wisconsin and Fox Rivers are largely surveyed and many early counties, towns, etc. appear. The region to the north is dominated by a massive Crawford County and St. Croix County. Brown. Portage, Chipewa and Lapoint are not yet established. These lands of the Winnebagos, Menomonies, Oneidas, Sioux New York and Chippewa Indians are shown prominently. Massive Carver claim remains, now nearly 100 years old. The south is filled with roads and towns, the north rivers, portages, etc.

One of the best early maps of Wisconsin in full original color.
