## **Description:**

Early example of the Boston Gazette, published in Boston.

The paper was started as a rival to *The Boston News-Letter*, the first successful newspaper in the Colonies, which had begun its long run in 1704. In 1741 the *Boston Gazette* incorporated the New-England *Weekly Journal* and became the *Boston-Gazette*, or *New-England Weekly Journal*. At the time, the publisher was Benjamin Edes, who published the paper from 1755 to 1794.
