Three apocryphal rivers of the west flow from the Pacific Coast to the Salt Lake region, R. Carmelo, R. San Francisco and Ouallamat (Willamette). A number of early forts shown, including Ft Manuel (Mandan) and Ft. De Dougal (on the Willamette). 54-40 or fight border w/Canada. An interesting ephemeral map, showing unusual details.
