Of personal interest, our current location is illustrated (Shirtales Men's Sportswear), with the archway leading to our shop shown on the left side of the vignette (but no sign of the Pannikin Coffee Shop, which was not opened until 1975, although the original location on 1296 Prospect was opened in 1968.

The Green Dragon Colony is shown, along with the Children's Pool, La Jolla Cove, La Jolla Shores, Scripps Institute, Scripps House, the original Scripps Clinic & Research Foundation, Bishop's School, etc.

Surf locations, noted by a 9 foot long board held up by a bathing suit clad couple, are shown at Wind 'n' Sea and La Jolla Shores. Decautur Elementary School and Scripps Elementary School are still open, as are John Cole's Book & Craft Shop and Frederick's Ski & Hike.
