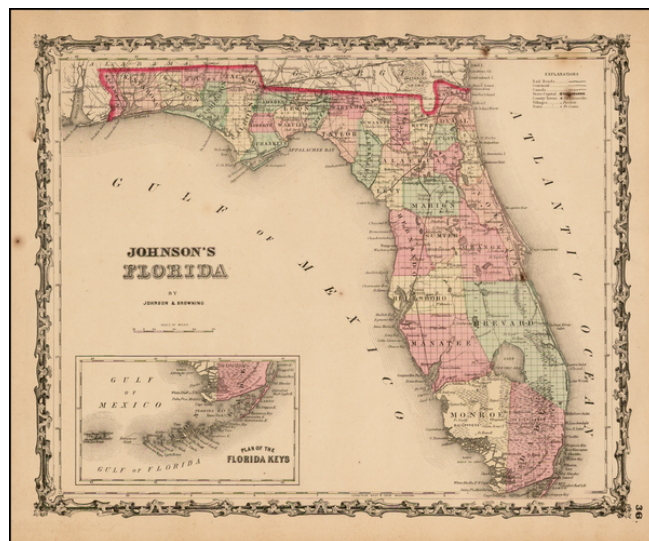

Description:

Detailed map of Florida, hand colored by counties, from an early edition of Johnson & Browning's Family Atlas. Shows towns, railroads, villages, post offices, forts, swamps, etc. Inset of the Keys. Only 5 counties shown in the southern part of Florida, including Dade, Monroe, Brevard, Manatee and Hillsboro. Early appearance of Miami.

Indian hunting grounds noted in between Ft. Poinsett and Key Biscayne Bay. Many early forts appear. The GLO surveys are not yet complete in the Everglades and elsewhere.

Decorative border. A nice Civil War map of Florida.
