The map shows the route from San Antonio to Saltillo, crossing the Rio Grande River between Laredo and Piedras Negras, Mexico. The map shows the southern Texas Coastline from Port Isabel and Matamoros to La Vaca Bay (Port La Vaca). Nice details shown along the Nueces River and San Antonio River, and tributaries. Parts of the Laredo Road, Lower Presidio Road, Gonzales Road, Nacogdoches Road and Seguin Road are shown, along with the various roads to Corpus Christi.
