Fine example of the northern 3 sheets of Norie's monumental map of the Pacific Ocean.

The map is noteworthy for the large insets views of San Francisco, San Diego, Hawaii, Honolulu and Karakakoa Bay in Hawaii.

Issued with revisions up to 1850, shortly after the California Gold Rush, Norie's map is the most comprehensive map of the Pacific available to commercial mariners.

An annotation on the chart extends from Korea to the southern tip of Sachalin Island.

First issued in 1825, this chart was re-issued in 1836 an 1850.

Detailed Condition:

Working sea chart. Laid on linen, with silk edges. Some soiling at edges, cracking, minor tears and very minor loss of image.
