Fine large format map of Scotland, flanked by city views on either side of the map, published in London by Herman Moll.

Moll was famously political in his maps, with characterist hubris for other nations. On this map, Moll marks the fishing grounds and states 'if things were rightly managed, there would be no reason to go to Norway for wood or New-found-land for fish; seeing North Britain can Plentifully furnish us with both'.

Detailed Condition:

A few marginal tears and minor repairs, but in all an excellent example.
