

Detailed map of Georgia, based upon the 1822 map by Carey & Lea. The western counties are still unformed and classified as Indian lands, including the Cherokis and Lower Creek. Massive Appling, Irwin and Early Counties dominate the south and are noted as being Indian Territories pursuant to the treaty of Ft. Jackson. The map shows counties, towns, roads, rivers, etc.

Interesting text in French shows numerous details concerning Georgia, including Rivers, Climate, Towns, Education, Religion, Commerce, Indian Details, Government, History, all the Governors beginning with Oglethorpe, and important Revolutionary War battles.
