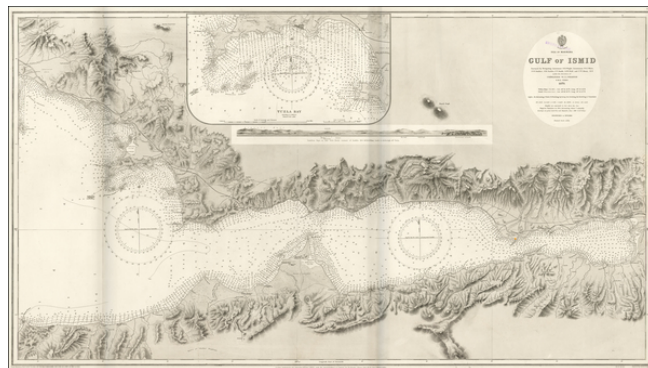

Detailed sea chart of the Gulf of Ismid, the easternmost part of the Sea of Marmara.

This elaborate and highly detailed chart extends from Ismid in the east to Sedef Island (Prince Islands), Kartal and the southeastern suburbs of Istanbul in the North, and Yalova and Çalica in the south. Major towns currently in the area shown include Gölcük, Körfez, and Gebze.

Fine topographical features, soundings, sailing directions, roads, and other features shown with a profile of Towshan Tepe and a large inset of Tuzla Bay.
