This map accompanied the first edition of the Mercator-Hondius atlas and was the only regional American map. It is a composite of John White's Virginia and Jacques Le Moynes Florida. Gold and Silver mines are located in the Apalacchy Mountains. A wild turkey and other game are illustrated, along with sea monsters, an indigenous canoe and sailing ships. This example is from the 1634 Dutch edition. Immediately before the sale of Hondius' plates to Blaeu. The map was also influenced by Wytfliet and Ribaut. A beautiful example with wide clean margins.
