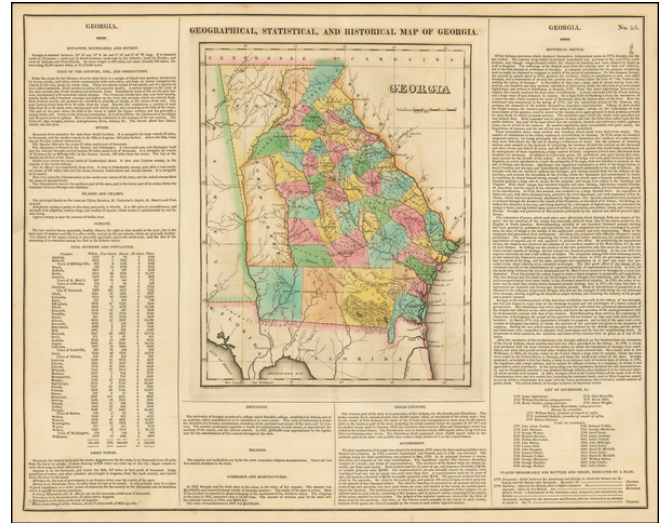

Description:

One of the earliest obtainable maps of Georgia in its modern configuration.

Nice example of this fine map of Georgia, from the 1822 edition of Carey & Lea's *Geographical, Statistical and Historical Atlas of America*, with two columns of contemporary news accounts pasted to the back of the map.

The map is shown subsequent to the creation of Mississippi Territory, which only began appearing on maps in the decade before publication of this map.

Many counties still not formed.

Size includes text below map, which features wonderful contemporary details concerning the topography, indigenous lands, rivers, climate, towns, manufacturing, commerce, education, history, population by county (divided into white, free colored, and slaves), Indian Country and other information. Large NW corner is Cherokee Lands, with Lower Creek lands below. Huge early, Irwin and Appling Counties shown. Below are East and West Florida.

An excellent early map of Georgia.

Carey & Lea's Atlas is highly prized not only for its cartographic information but the marvelous information about each of the states and territories which is included. The atlas was issued in 6 editions in English, French and German between 1822 and 1827.
